- Build skills associated with their distance learning environment.

- Participaten pretraining (4 hours in total, dates and times TBD)
 - o Technology and platform integration
 - o Review lesson exemplars/templates
 - Calibration of deliverables
- Collaborate weekly with the district'signal fless ning support teams to ensure coordination of efforts and deliverables
