Recommendation: Approve Resolution No. 2819: Recognition of National No One Eats Alone Day, February 13, 2015.

Background/Rationale: No One Eats Alone Day is sponsored by Beyond Differences, a nonprofit founded by the parents of Lili Smith, who was born with a cranial facial syndrome and was socially isolated during her middle school years. After Lili died at the age of 15 from medical complications associated with her syndrome, a group of her former classmates from the local cochools safer and healthier places for children to learn. SCUSD was one of the first districts in the region to pass a sweeping anti-bullying policy and remains the only local district to employ a full-time Bullying Prevention Specialist. SCUSD is also one of only eight districts nationwide to participate in a Social Emotional Learning cohort funded by the NoVo Foundation.
