#### BP 4119.21 (Professi8thanhdards)

- Revisions include (but are not limited to):
  - Providing examplesima propriate conduct (e.g. Engaging in inappropriate socialization or fraternization with a student or soliciting, encouraging maintaining an inappropriate written, verbal, or physical relationship with a student);
  - Providing guidelines for reporting misconduct

# BP 4119.24 (Maintaining Appropriated Adult-Student Interactions)

- District staff are mandated child abuse reportersTheDistrict faces liability in situations of child abuse where reports s have been made. The District owes a dut care over students under its supervision.
- This will be a new policy for the District t adopt based off the model provided by th CSBA and language from District administrators.

# BP 4119.24 (Maintaining Appropri Adult-Student Interactions)

 Theupdates are intended to established policy for all adults with whom students interact at school or in schlabed activities in order to prevent unlawful or inappropri interactions with students and to avoid boundaryblurring behaviors that undermine trust in the adsitudent relationship.
