| Recommendation: Approve Amendment to extend Yav Pem Suab Academy's Facilit Use Agreement   |

<u>Background/Rationale</u>: Pursuant Education Code 47614 ("Proposition 39"), public school facilities should be shared fairly among all public school pupils, including those in Charter Schools. Each school district shall make available, facilities sufficient for the charter school to accommodate all of the charter schools' in-district students in conditions reasonably equivalent to those in other public schools of the district. The Charter Schools pay the District "Facility Use Fees" based on a pro rata share facilities cost for the use of District facilities. The master Facility Use Agreement for future use by all Charter Schools is currently being updated and revised with an anticipated completion date of February 28, 2019. By mutual agreement between the District and Yav Pem Suab Academy, the Amendment extends the expiration of the current Facilities Use Agreement and related first extension Amendment from June 30, 2019 to June 30, 2020. The Amendment eliminates the need for Yav Pem Suab Academy to submit a Prop 39 Facility Request due no later than November 1, 2018 for the school year 2019-20.

<u>Financial Considerations</u>: The District will continue to receive from Yav Pem Suab Academy the pro rata share of the facilities costs.
