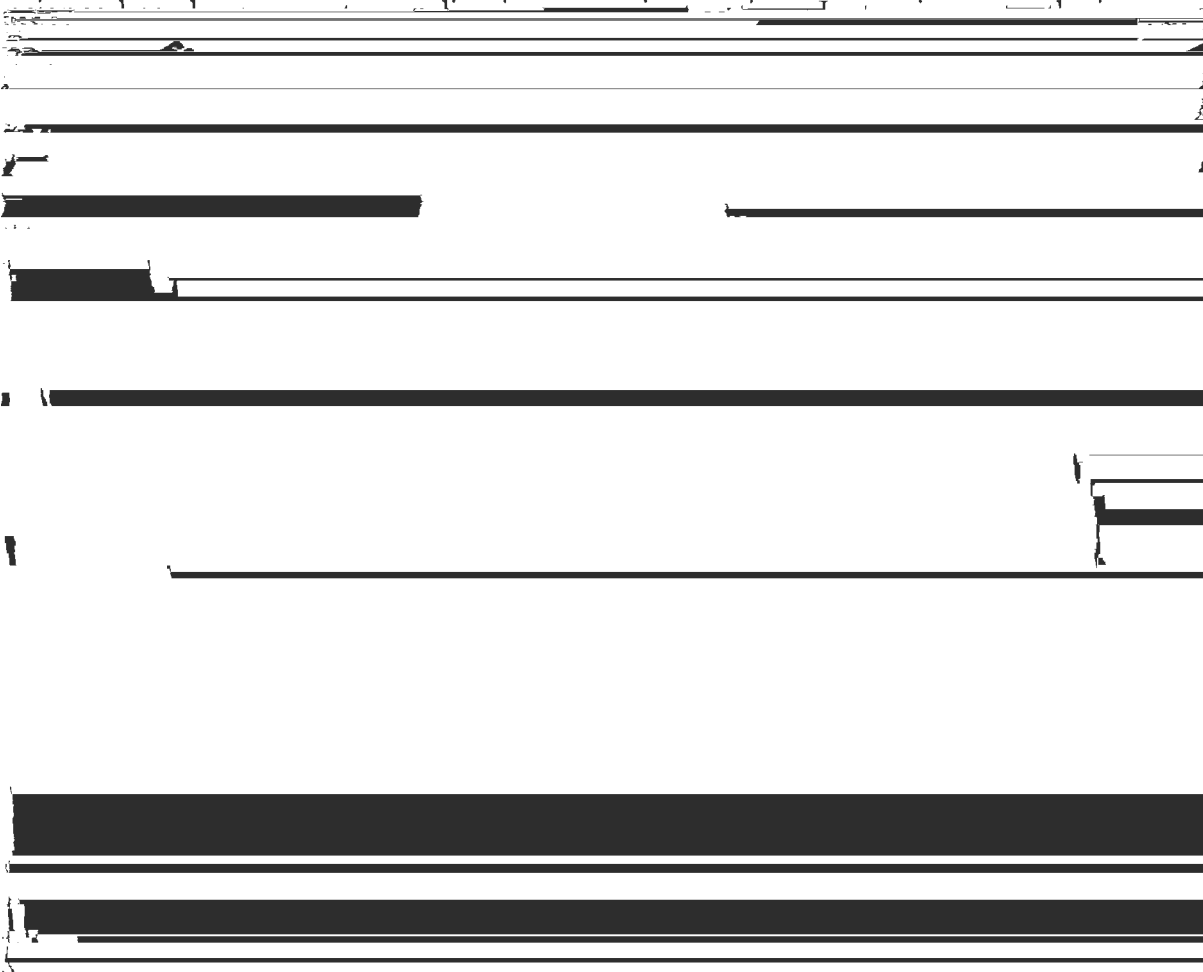
We especially want to welcome to Sac City new board members Phillips, Rhodes and Villa.
