This includes the identification of the “appropriate” level of support for a school (those “fixed” needs, such as administrative assistants, clerks, plant managers, custodians, etc.). We are interested in working together with the district to speed up the process of setting staffing numbers so that all sites can start the year with the appropriate level of staffing. We are currently moving into March with numerous positions still unfilled. The system shouldn't have to work that way.

Evaluation - UPE is interested in the development of a new administrative evaluation instrument that is a collaborative effort between SCUSD and UPE.
