Only after a concept/skill has been taught and practiced should grades be kepgrade book. Multiple opportunities should be given for each student to master a standard. Student should be able to consistently show proficiency. Several pieces of evidence will be collected to look at a student performance over period oftime. In the traditional way of grading, a student's grading would be averaged out. With tstandardsbased grading, it is the most recent grades that should be weighted more heavily.
