FOR STUDENTS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS OR HOUSING INSTABILITY
IN SACRAMENTO CITY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT Who are unhoused and

experiencing homelessness.

Students are unhoused/homeless if they lack a fixed, regular, & adequate nighttime residence, such as:

- x Temporarily moved in with others due to loss of housing or financial problems (eviction, job loss, etc.)
- x In a motel/hotel, campground, or trailer due to a lack of alternative adequate accommodations
- x In a shelter or a shelter transitional housing program
- x A public/private place that is not designed for or normally used as a place for sleeping
- x Cars, parks/public spaces, abandoned/condemned buildings, bus/train stations, or similar settings
- x Homeless students also include unaccompanied youth, runaways, children abandoned in hospitals, and migratory children who live in the conditions described above.

The Homeless Services Office can help with:

- x Eligibility for rights and services under McKinney-Vento and other Federal and State programs
- x School enrollment and attendance issues
- x Coordination of school services
- x Dispute mediation and resolution
- x Emergency transportation assistance for school
- x Community information on housing, shelter, basic needs
- x Information for school supplies & other student resources
