RESOLUTION REGARDING PROPOSED DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 44949 and 44955 of the California Education Code, the Board of Education of the Sacramento City Unified School District ("Board") has considered the findings, recommendations, or determinations contained in the proposed decision by the Honorable Catherine B. Frink, Administrative Law Judge, in the Matter of Certificated Layoffs of Sacramento City Unified School District, OAH Case Number 2011010622; and

WHEREAS, the proposed decision sets forth the determination that sufficient cause exists for the elimination of full time equivalent positions, as described in the proposed decision set forth in Exhibit A, and recommends that notice be given the certificated employees holding these positions that their services will not be required for the 2011-2012 school year; and

WHEREAS, section 44949 of the California Education Code requires the Board to make the final decision as to the sufficiency of the cause and disposition regarding certificated employee layoffs;

positions are to be eliminated for the 2011-12 school year, the Superintendent is directed, consistent with budget constraints, to continuously review for recommendation and restoration of positions in accordance with the needs of the District and the Education Code.
