Revisiting Committee Norms

Overall:

- Expenditures/strategies tied to best practices and demonstrated how they benefit underrepresented groups
- Target metrics and investment priorities by student groups
- More accountability around expenditures like CT, CSR, SSC
- Coaches
- A prioritized list of actions/strategies can guide informed allocations when funds arrive
- Need transparency regarding which actions or strategies are based on decisions already made
- Consider modeling process for a specific strategy to show what all expenditures should go through
- Qualitative information can be just as informative
- Sites need to be sufficiently resources
- When we prototype we need to clearly communicate what we can actually replicate/scale
- Need to end on a positive culture –discuss with board
