Petition shall be granted unless:

Unsound education program

Petitioners unlikely to successfully implement program

Absence of required affirmations



A charter school seeking renewal must also meet one of the standards for academic achievement as set forth in Education Code §47607.



## **Academic Criteria for Renewal:**

Attained API growth target in the prior year or in two of the last three years

Ranked in deciles 4 to 10, inclusive, on the API in the prior year or in two of the last three years

Ranked in deciles 4 to 10, inclusive, on the API for similar schools

Charter school's performance is at least equal to district schools students otherwise would attend



District Staff has thoroughly reviewed PS7's renewal petition:

Overall, the petition meets the requirements of charter school laws, including the academic performance standards and the 16 elements.
