Title IX, Including Updates for 2024 Regulations Online Training Requirements

Title IX is a landmark federal civil rights law in the United States that was enacted as part (Title IX) of the Education Amendments of 1972, prohibiting sex-based discrimination in any school or any other education program that receives funding from the federal government. New landmark regulations for Title IX go into effect on August 1, 2024, with 2020 regulations remaining in effect for incidents occurring prior to August 1, 2024.

CA Workplace Violence Prevention Plan (WVPP) Online Training Requirements

Beginning July 31, 2024, all employees of the State of California are required to complete the WVPP Online Training Requirements. This training is mandatory for all employees, regardless of their position or whether they are working in a high-risk area. The training is available in both English and Spanish. Employees who do not complete the training by the deadline may be subject to disciplinary action. For more information, please contact your supervisor or the HR department.

Fire Safety and Fire Extinguisher Use – Online Training Requirements

In accordance with 8CCR 3221, employer training shall be provided relating to fire safety and the proper use of a fire extinguisher. This training outlines the employer requirement to control accumulations of flammable and combustible waste materials and residues so they do not contribute to a fire emergency, in addition to providing awareness for classroom applications.

Homeless Education Serving Students under the McKinney-Vento Act – Online Training Requirements
