**“COMMITTING TO RETURNING STUDENTS TO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION BY THE
FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL YEAR 2021-22 AND MITIGATING LEARNING LOSS”**

WHEREAS, as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, all Sacramento City Unified School

District (“SCUSD”) schools temporarily closed to in-person instruction beginning March 16, 2020;
and

WHEREAS, students have shown incredible resilience in the face of historic circumstances, educators and staff have put in tireless work to teach in unprecedented ways, and families have juggled simultaneously working in a pandemic and supporting distance learning; an

WHEREAS, in-person learning historically has proven to be the most effective form of learning for the majority of students because it allows them to develop socially and emotionally while exploring ideas and discussing social situations across their teachers and peers; and

WHEREAS the District has undertaken a review of its facilities and ability to implement
