

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE RESOURCE TEACHER, ELEMENTARY

DEFINITION

Under the direction of the principal, the resource teacher will work with children, classroom teachers, paraprofessionals, other specialists, and parents in designing and providing a program of diagnosis and prescription, to integrate the implementation and evaluation of instructional activities. The aim of the program will be to provide over and above services to identified children in the areas of reading, language and mathematics at the elementary level.

QUALIFICATIONS

The minimum requirements are a bachelor's degree, a valid California Elementary Teaching Credential, and demonstrated competency in the area of reading and mathematics instruction.

Prerequisites are good health, emotional stability, flexibility, and an ability to work effectively with children and adults. Priority consideration shall be given to candidates who have undertaken advanced college courses and/or clinical training in diagnosis and prescription or who show a willingness to pursue such studies in the first year of service.
