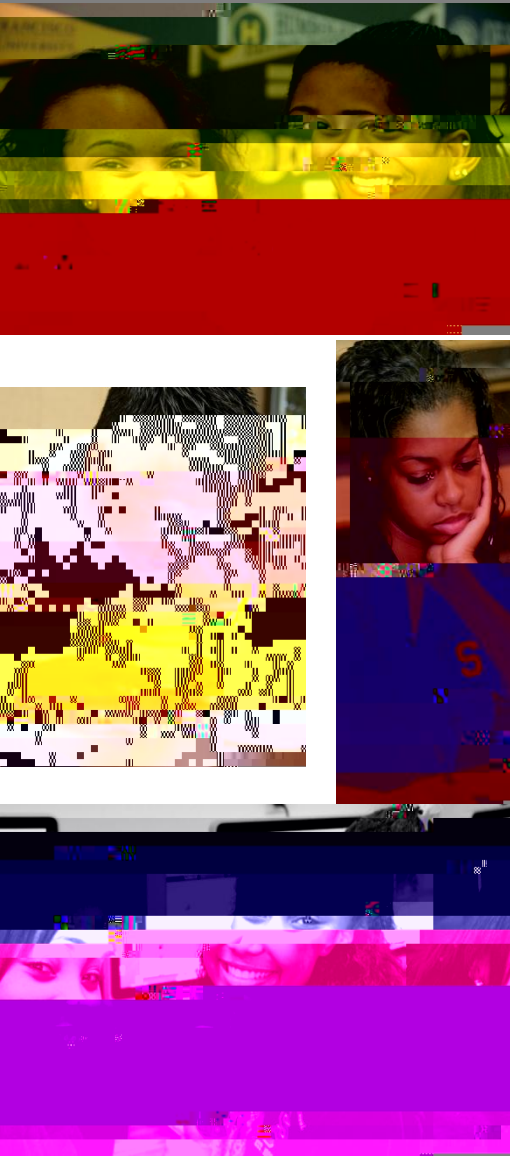

To create one of the finest urban public high schools in America



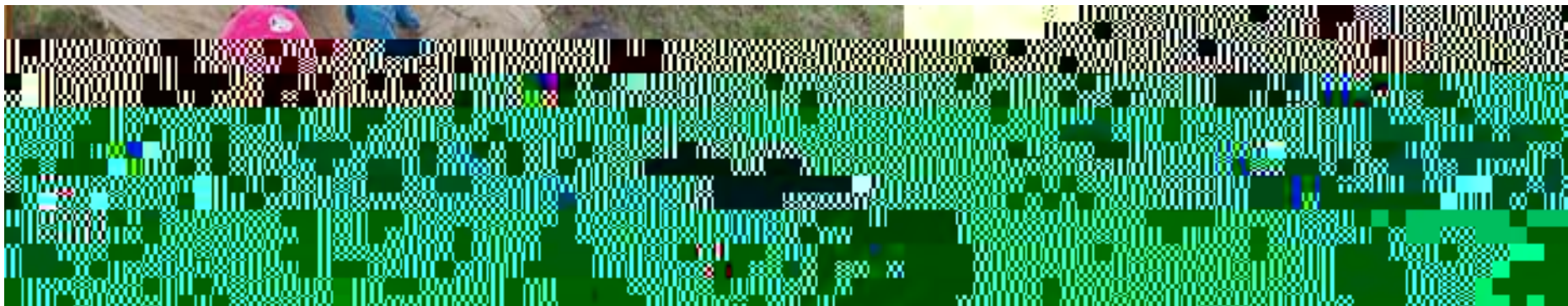


Choice and Commitment

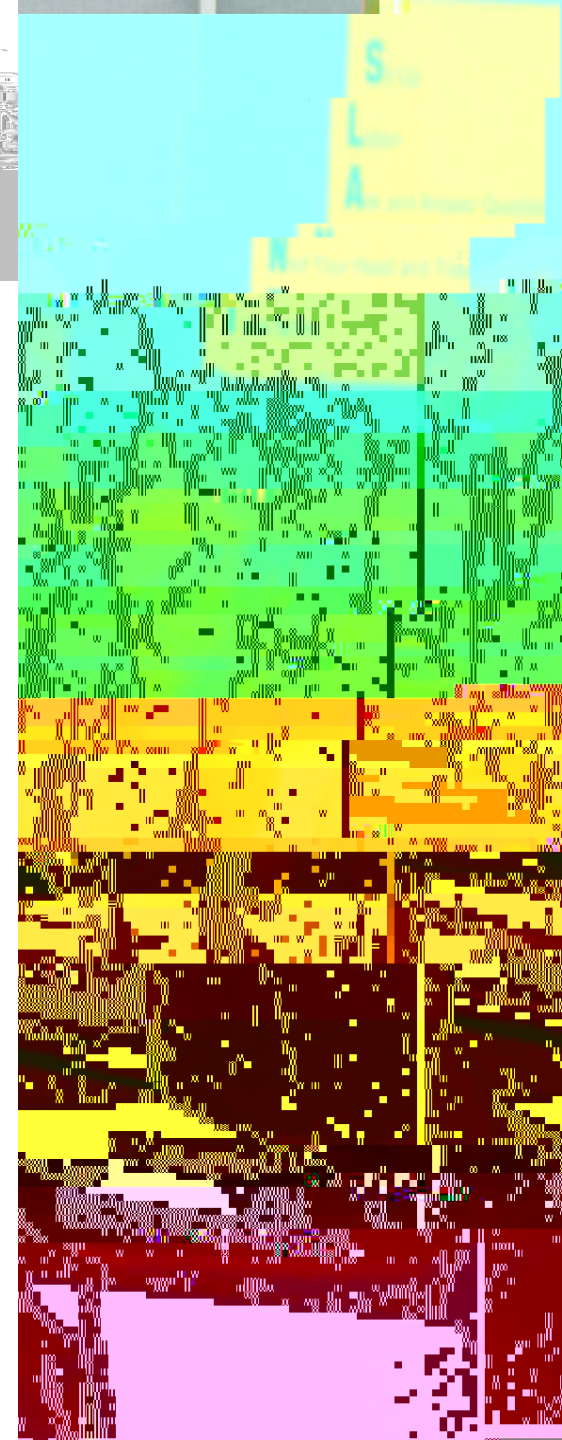

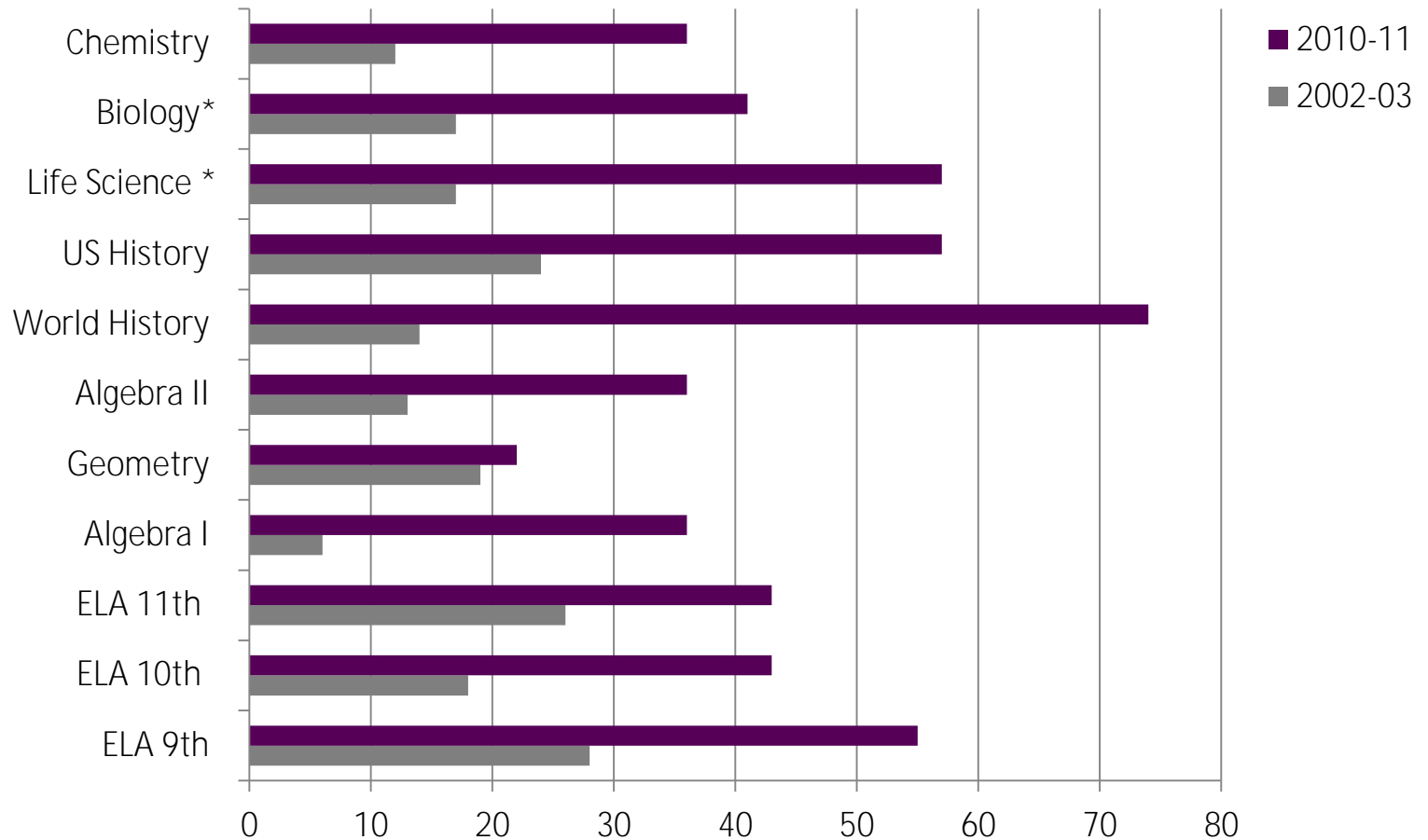

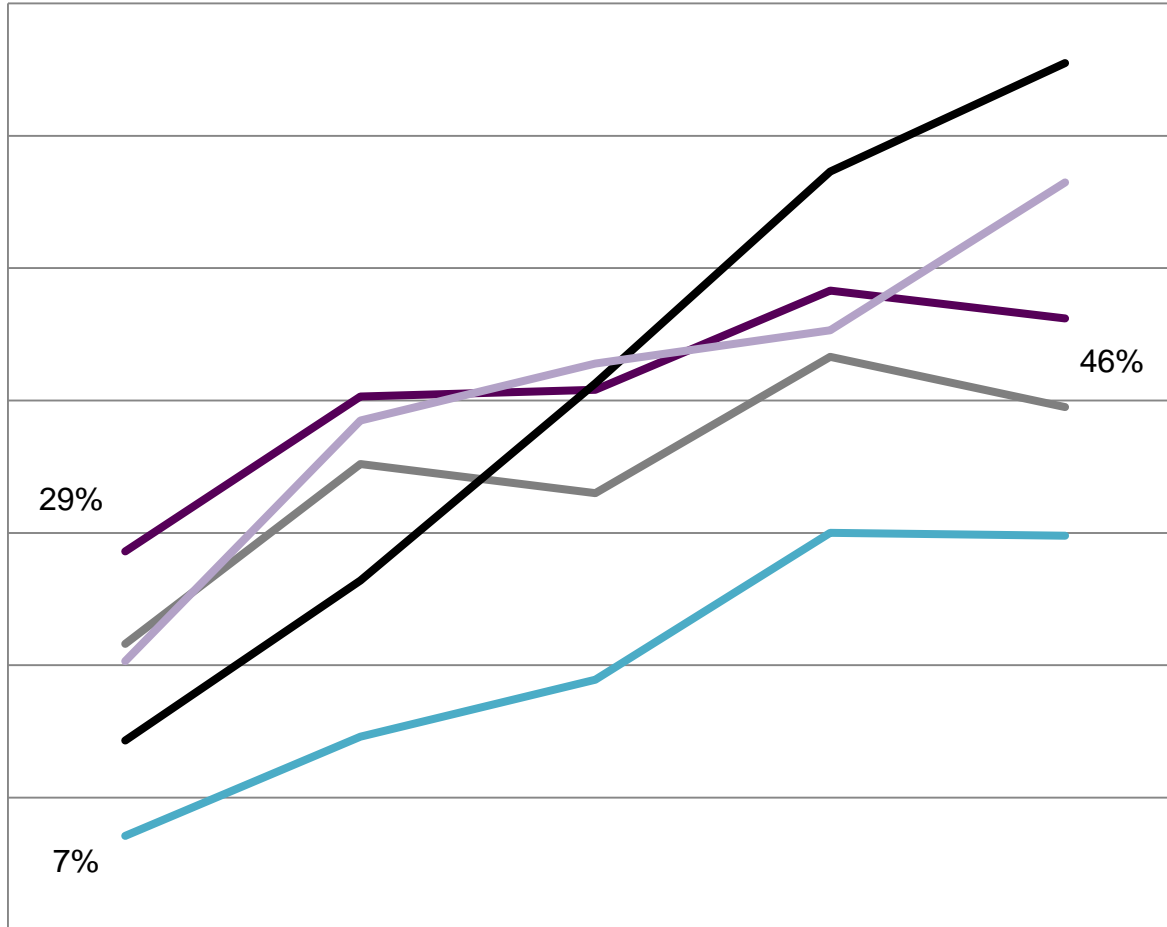
CST Results

CST Results (2007-11)

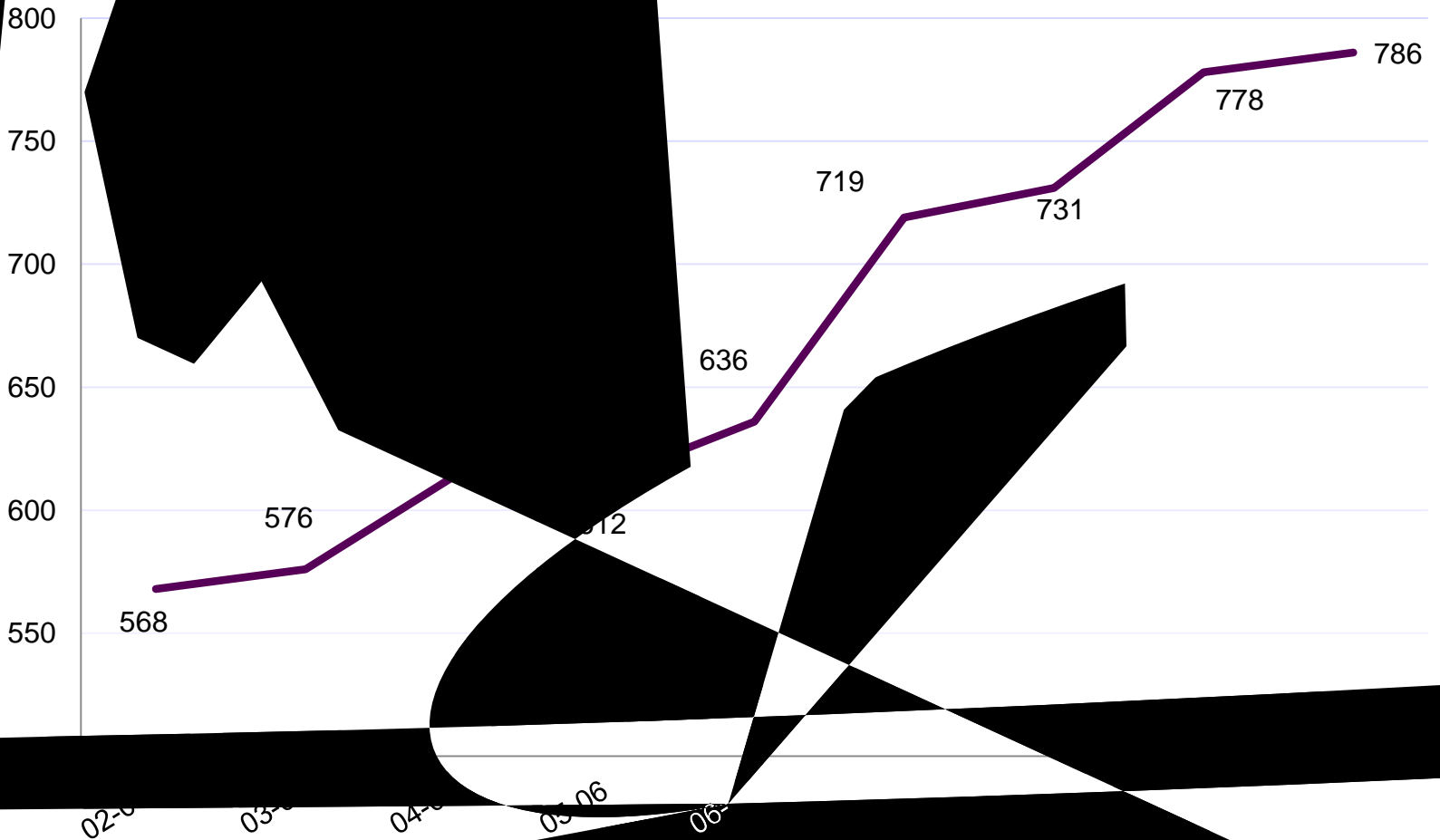
Percent of Students Proficient or Advanced

State vs. Sac High API

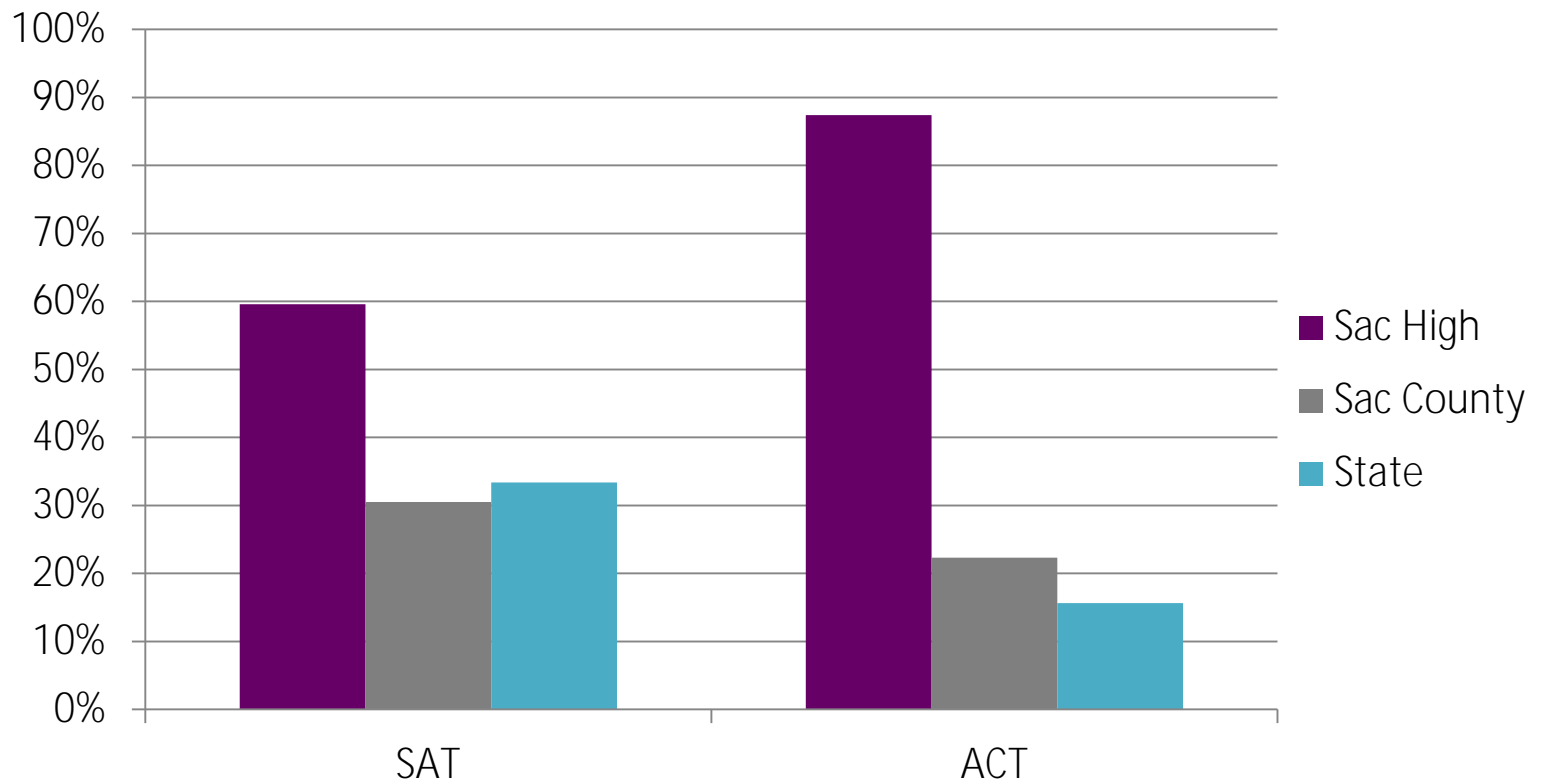

2010* SAT/ACT Participation

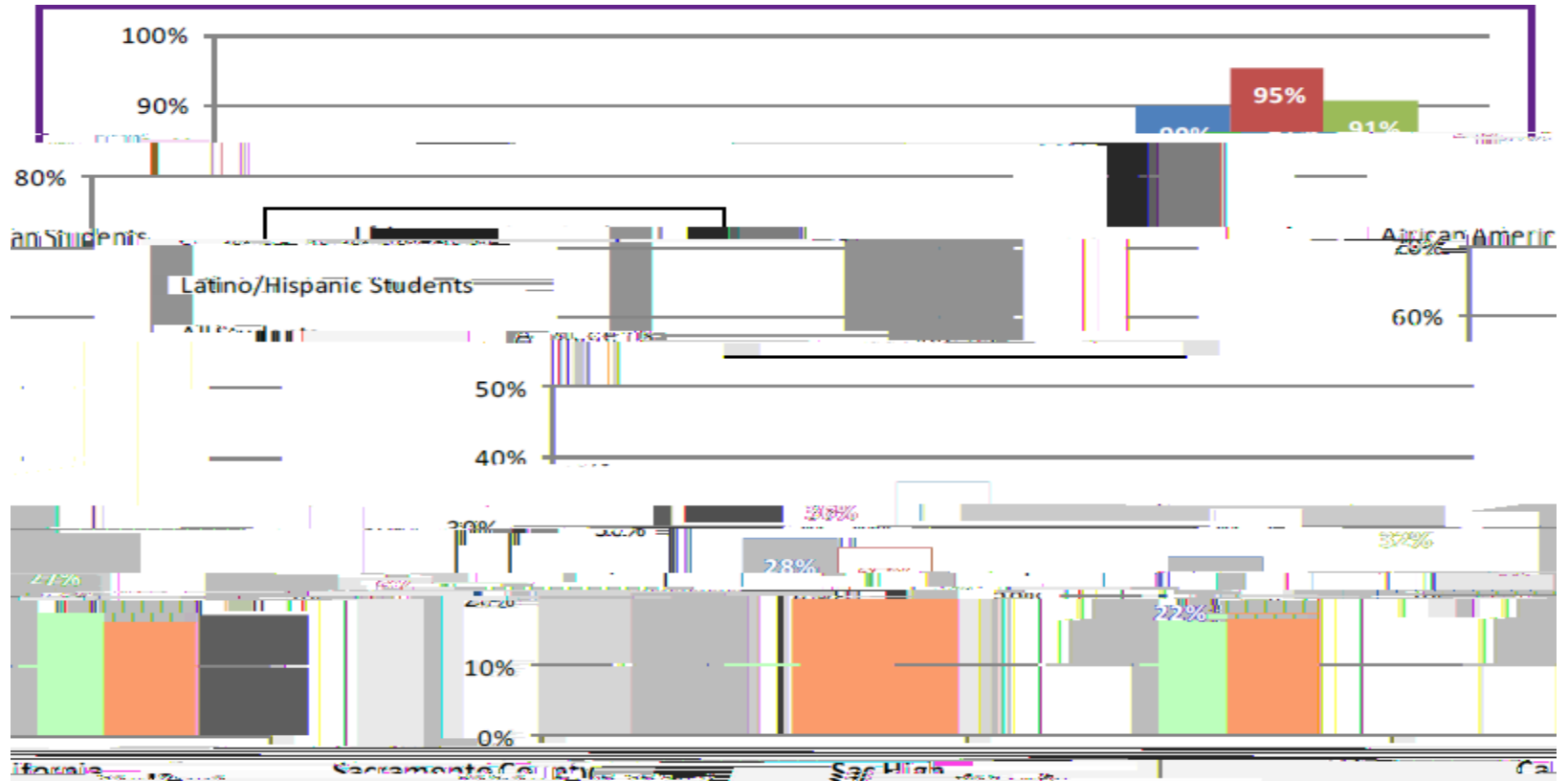
77% of the Class of 2011 took the SAT and 87% took the ACT

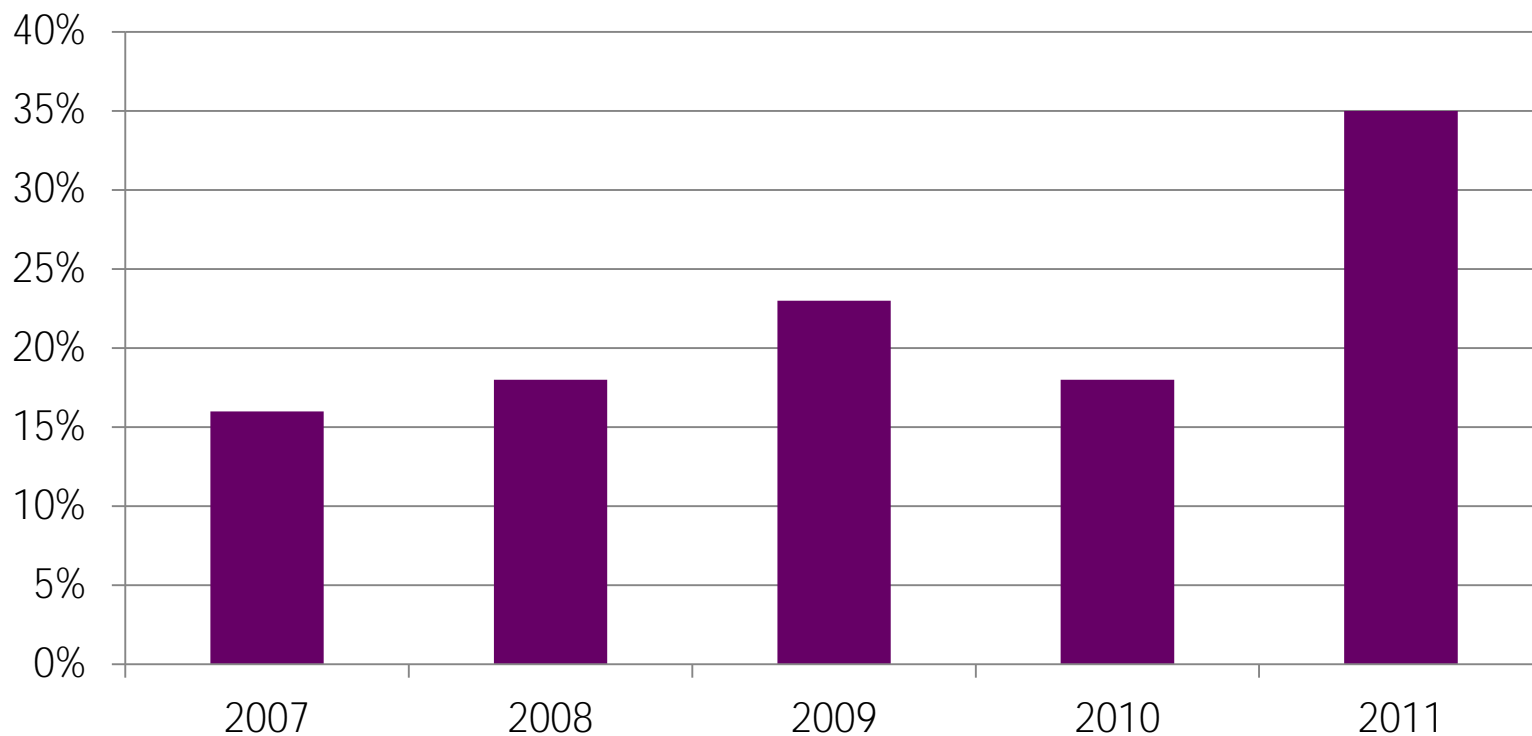

2011 AP Results – Highest to Date

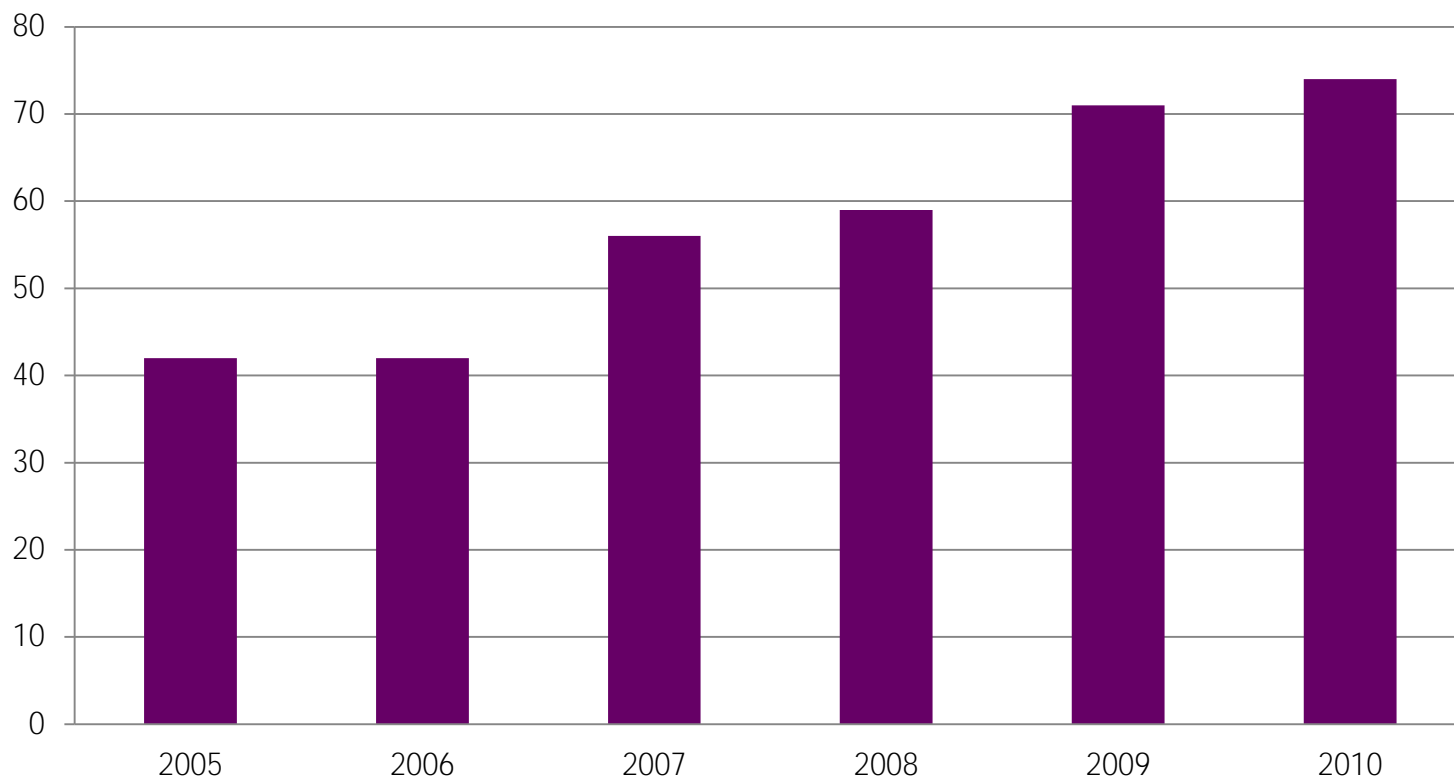
