# Employee Tips for Accessing TB Screening

## The TB Clearance Process

TB Risk Assessment Questionnaire

Skin Test (PPD) – Employees who have never previously had a positive TB skin test, and do not pass the TB Risk Assessment, will need to get a TB skin test (PPD). If an employee passes the TB skin test, they will be provided with documentation to take to Human Resources, which will satisfy the TB clearance requirement for 4 years.

X-Ray – Employees who do not pass the TB skin test (PPD) need to see their medical provider for an examination, and likely chest x-ray. Employees who have already submitted a chest x-ray report to HR, will need to complete the Employee Tuberculin Testing Questionnaire every 4 years: [https://www.scusd.edu/sites/main/files/file\\_attachments/psl\\_-](https://www.scusd.edu/sites/main/files/file_attachments/psl_-)
