Thank you.</p> <p>However, I feel completely disrespected and disregarded as an employee when there are two weeks left on my employee calendar for the current school year AND WE STILL HAVE NO FORMAL COMMUNICATION FROM HUMAN RESOURCES REGARDING OUR RETURN TO WORK DATES FOR 2024/25. I know the district needed to wait to learn from CDE when we would be starting the school year. But there is no excuse for it being an entire month since the August 19th school start date was announced and still ZERO communication for us. How are SCUSD employees to fully utilize their summer break to relax and recharge for a employee wellness and self-care if we are merely guessing what date we are to report to work in August?</p> <p>SCUSD has a recruitment and retention problem...
